



*Code of Conduct
For
Affiliate Members/Riders*

On your voluntary affiliation with Fellowship Riders, Inc. (FRI), your conduct should be in accord with the values of The Holy Bible and the New Testament Church, which is the Body of Christ. The actions of one or all of the above reflect; either favorably or unfavorably; on Fellowship Riders, Inc. (FRI), the affiliate church, and the cause of Christ.

As "born again" Believers, we are called to exhibit the character and nature of Christ, to honor Him in the way we live, to draw un-Believers to Him by our example and testimony, and to love and serve one another. A FRI affiliate and its members/participants should not plan nor engage in activities that would not glorify our Lord Jesus Christ. By wearing or displaying any Fellowship Riders apparel, patches, decals, flags, or logos, you have identified yourself as a Believer in Christ, a representative of the affiliate church body, and a Fellowship Rider.

Alcohol & Illegal Substances – No public consumption, purchase, or possession of alcoholic beverages or the use/abuse of prescription or illegal drugs by affiliates or their members/participants as part of a sponsored Fellowship Riders activity is to be allowed. The dangers of riding or driving when drinking or impaired do not need to be restated. Members wearing or exhibiting any Fellowship Riders logos or other identifying symbols should not publicly consume alcohol or illegal substances or promote the use of alcohol or banned substances.

Profanity, inappropriate language, public disturbance, obscene gestures – We are to be set apart, in the world but not of the world, Salt and Light to a dark and lost generation – not to be indistinguishable from the very people we have been called to lead to Salvation in Christ. As Believers and Fellowship Riders, we should seek to control our speech and behavior as Ambassadors for Christ and will be accountable to each other and to our Sovereign Lord for our example and witness wherever we go.

FRI affiliates and/or their members, if violating this Code of Conduct, will be asked to refrain from representing themselves as being associated with Fellowship Riders until requesting a return to good standing and affirming agreement with the intent and purpose of this Code of Conduct. As Christians it is our call to forgive and seek restoration with those who may have stumbled if they demonstrate a genuine spirit of contrition and repentance.

The Board of Directors of Fellowship Riders, Inc. applauds and encourages your ministry to the lost, the widow, the orphan, the alcoholic, the drug abuser, and the prisoner and recognizes that in the course of evangelism and ministry, you must go where those needing to hear the Good News are found. But you must also be aware that these same places will be used by Satan to destroy your witness and where you are vulnerable to attack unless you have put on the full armor of God.

We pray for you and affirm your ministry for the Kingdom through your affiliation with Fellowship Riders, Inc.
